Building Starts

Building starts provide the most accurate method in determining the level of economic activity in the construction industry. Appendix A

The northern parishes of St. Lucy, St. Andrew, St. Peter, St. Joseph and sections of St. James and St. Thomas encompass **Area C**. **Area D** consists of sections of Christ Church, St. Philip, St. John, and sections of St. Andrew and St. Joseph; while **Area E** is made up of the south-eastern parts of Christ Church and St. Philip.
