Building Starts

Building starts provide the most accurate method in determining the level of economic activity in the construction industry. The table below indicates the total number of building starts requested for the month of May 2012 was **ninety-eight (98)**, and **sixty-eight (68)** were issued. Area C accounted for the largest number of building starts requested at **forty (40)** and also issued at a total of **twenty-nine (29)**.

Appendix A

The northern parishes of St. Lucy, St. Andrew, St. Peter, St. Joseph and sections of St. James and St. Thomas encompass **Area C**. **Area D** consists of sections of Christ Church, St. Philip, St. John, and sections of St. Andrew and St. Joseph; while **Area E** is made up of the south-eastern parts of Christ Church and St. Philip.
